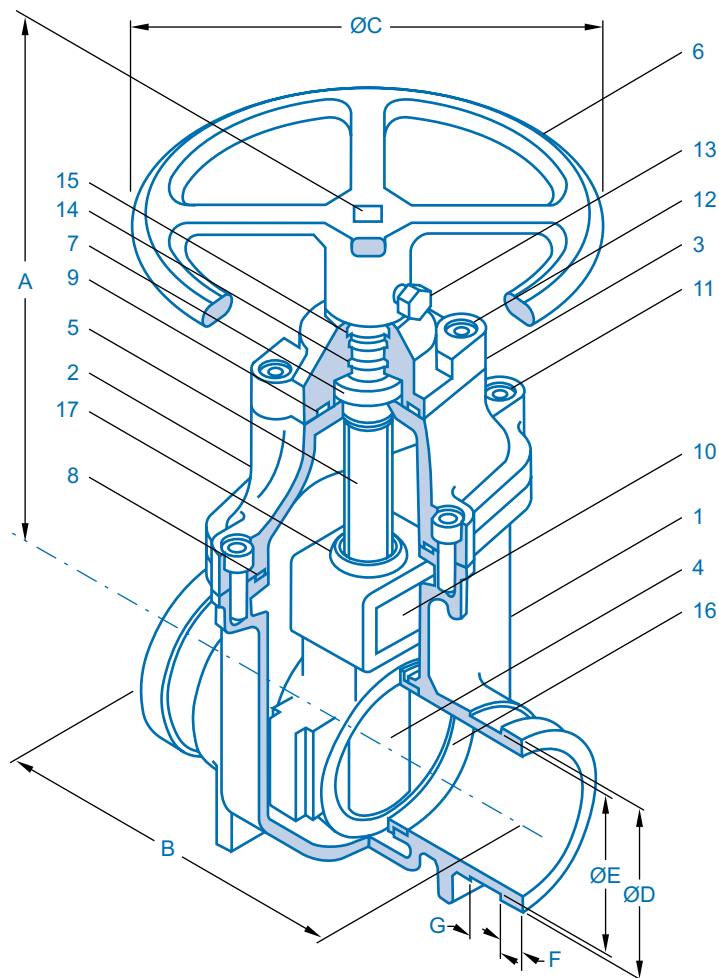
Figure 600 metal seated gate valves are suitable for use with water or waste water applications. Shouldered spigot end gate valves are commonly used in mining and fire service applications.
